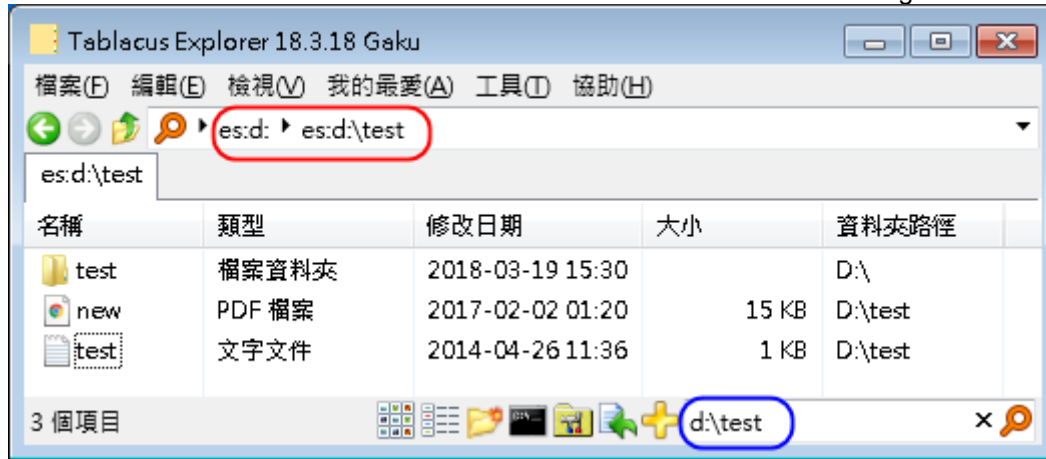


## Problem 1: Incorrect address

Incorrect address shown in breadcrumbs address bar when the search string contains \

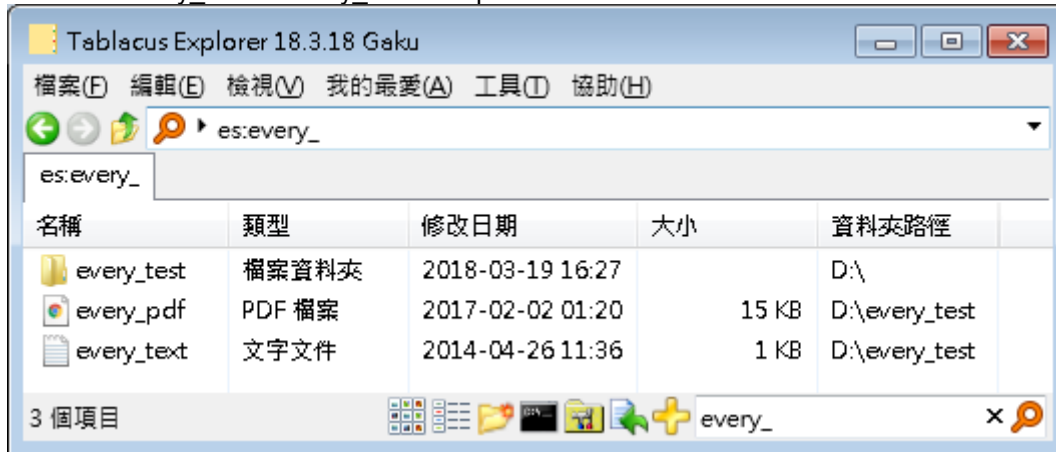


## Problem 2: Unnecessarily and incorrectly re-matches search string

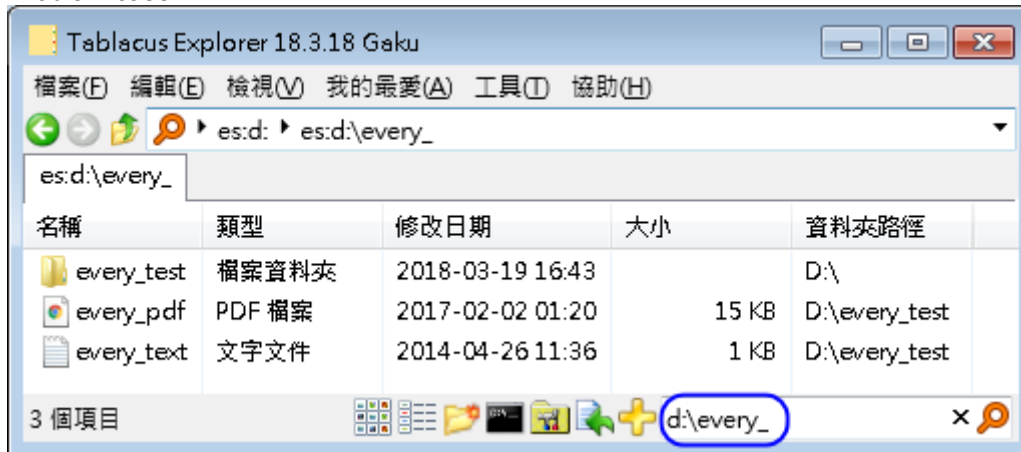
Normal case:



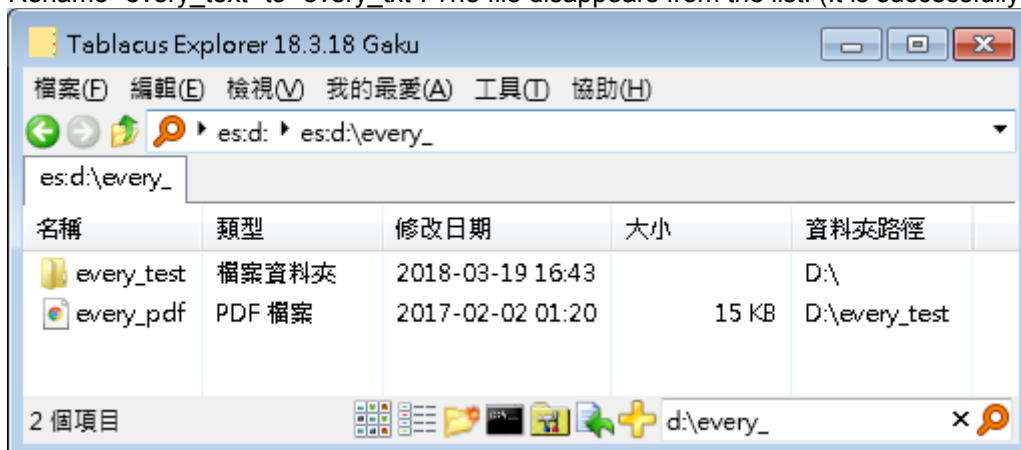
Rename "every\_txt" to "every\_text". No problem.



Problem case:

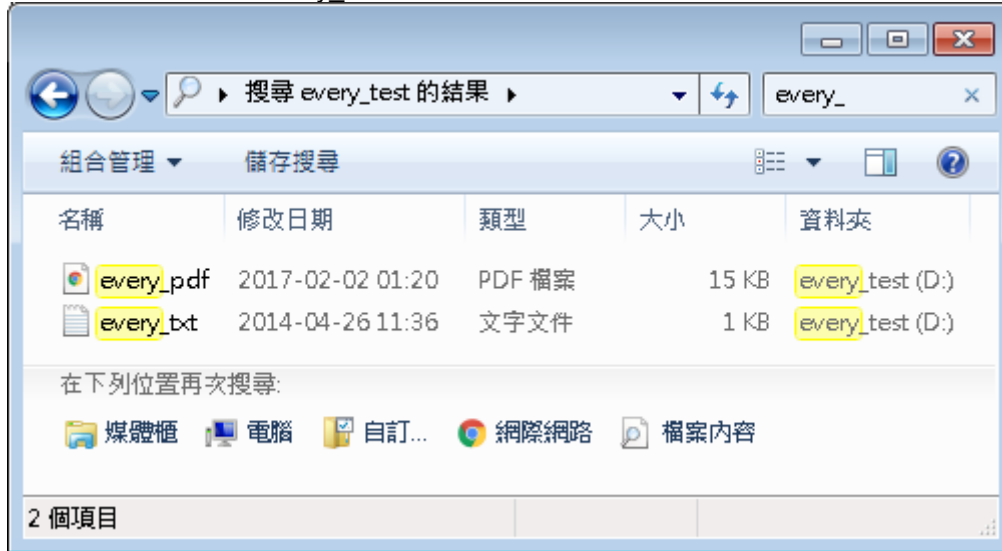


Rename "every\_text" to "every\_txt". The file disappears from the list. (It is successfully renamed.)

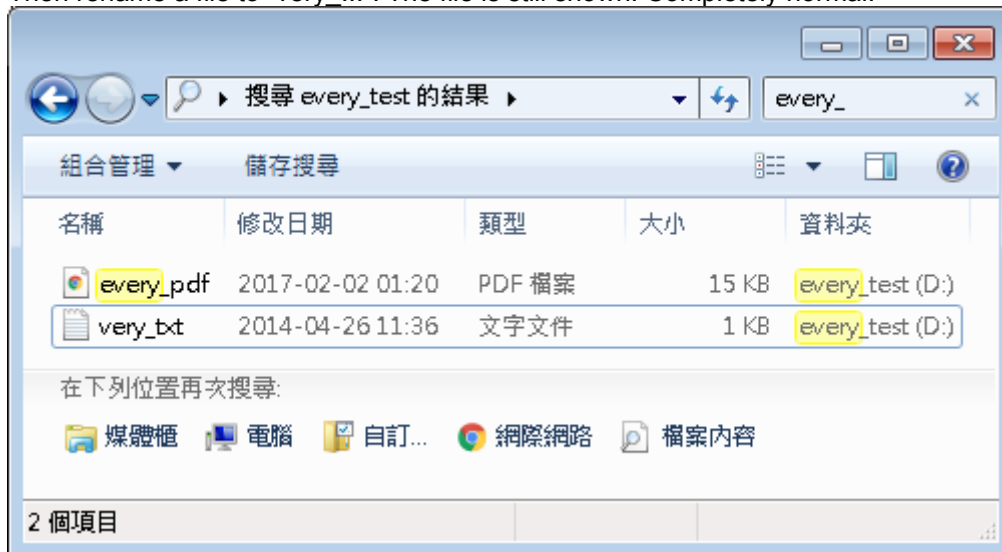


The add-on seems to re-match the search string with the new name. The file disappears since they do not match. This re-matching process is unnecessary and incorrect since:

1. After a search result is shown, a user may do something to a file which makes the file no longer matches the search criteria. But the file should still be shown until the user refreshes the list manually. This is a common way. For example, if I use Windows Search to search for "every\_":



Then rename a file to "very\_...". The file is still shown. Completely normal.



2. Everything search may not be a file name search. The search string may contain a folder path, keywords, operators, etc. Matching a file name with Everything search string is incorrect.
