History Flat Everything Find Files Empty folder	Folder View	<p>TE incorrectly indicates a result list as sorted by name initially if the list is opened in a new tab. 5 types of result lists have this problem:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - History - Flat - Everything - Find Files - Empty folder <p>These 5 types are exactly those cannot sort according to "Folder Settings", and thus "Folder Settings" version 1.20 does not generate any sorting instruction for them.</p> <p>After an investigation, it is found that when these result lists are opened in a current tab, there is not any incorrect sort indication problem.</p> <p>Although they do not appear as sorted, "Folder Settings" version 1.19 generates the following sorting instruction:</p> <p>FV.SortColumns='prop:-System.Search.Rank;-System.DateModified;System.ItemNameDisplay';</p> <p>Therefore it makes sense to put this instruction in the add-on to solve the problem. I have tried such patched versions of the add-ons. So far they work. Please create new versions of the add-ons based on the patched versions.</p>	Fix	3-Medium
TE	Panes	<p>Do the followings on an inactive pane but cannot activate it:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. hover the mouse pointer on an item [scroll or not] 2. hover the mouse pointer on a file list and scroll (need to wait for a while) 3. click the tab area (need to wait for a while) 4. click the file list when there is no selection (need to wait for a while) 5. click the file list when there is a selection [scroll or not] <p><i>[TE 18.3.30 and before does not have this problem]</i></p>	Fix	2-High
